Where will I stay?

We encourage you to stay in one of the official hotels, so that you may take advantage of the free bus service between the venue and your hotel. The official event hotels are Hotel D'Angleterre, Tivoli Hotel and Congress Center and Radisson Blu Royal Hotel. How will I get around Copenhagen?

Bus services will be provided free of charge between the designated hotels, the meeting venue and the official evening programme. A detailed time schedule is available below and will also be available at the conference hotels from 25 October. Please be aware that the buses will leave on time.

There will be no transportation arrangements for those not staying at the official hotels. For your convenience, taxi companies operating in Copenhagen have been notified of the time schedule for the Danish Maritime Forum. Individual transportation is not provided for and will be at your own expense. If you need book individual transportation, please contact MCI and they will advise you on this.

Please note that transport times between different locations in Copenhagen may differ from day to day. We recommend that you to arrive at the meeting well in advance to network with your colleagues from around the world.

What is the working language of the Danish Maritime Forum?

All sessions will be held in English. Simultaneous interpretation will not be available due to the interactive format of much of the programme, but should you require translation services, you may bring a whispering interpreter to the meeting at your own cost. What weather conditions can I expect in Copenhagen in October?

October can be a beautiful time of year, with many cool but sunny days. However, do be sure to bring an umbrella, a warm coat and sweater. Day temperatures continue their steady fall to an average of only 10°C (50°F). It is the season with late sunrise and early sundown with an average of 8 hours of daylight.

How can I support the sustainability initiatives of the Forum?

A central ambition of the Danish Maritime Forum is to discuss sustainable growth within the maritime industry. In keeping with this, the Forum is continuously committed to increasing the positive environmental, social and economic impacts of the event. In 2015, the MeetGreen® calculator – which evaluates over 150 best practices to measure performance and determines an overall meeting sustainability score – was used to evaluate the sustainability performance of the Danish Maritime Forum. The Danish Maritime Forum 2015 earned an overall meeting sustainability score of 72 out of 100. Coming from a score of 51 in 2014, the ambition is to build on the results and experiences from our sustainability initiatives of the past two years. In 2015, the largest CO2 emissions impact originated from international air travel, constituting 94% of the total Forum emissions, and we encourage you to compensate the CO2 emissions from you flight.
